## The types of data recorded on catalog records are divided into <u>four</u> categories:

1 – Bibliographic Data

2 – Physical Characteristics

3 - Archival control

4 - Subject(s)

And can be cataloged three different ways (or levels).

### Bibliographic Data

- Original title
- Country of origin
- Director / Recording artist
- Production company / Recording studio / Record label
- Year of production and/or release
- Language conditions
- Location of physical item in collection

### Physical Characteristics

number of items comprising the work/number of items held

Ex: 1 sound disc OR Ex: 3 film reels

- length (in feet or meters) / run-time of disc
- format (gauge or width / size and type of disc)
- sound status, audio: playback speed
- any serious defects
- Preservation notes
- For film: color status (B&W, Color)
- For film: degree of completeness

#### **Technical Metadata**

- File size (ex: 15 KB)
- File type (ex: MPEG-4 Quicktime, WAV)
- Transfer information:
  - Equipment / Software Used To Transfer
  - For audio:
    - Mono or stereo
    - Stylus size
    - EQ curve
  - For video:
    - FPS (Frames per second)
    - Mbps (megabytes per second)

#### **Archival Control**

- date of acquisition
- source of acquisition
- method of acquisition (eg... gift, deposit, purchase, exchange, etc.)
